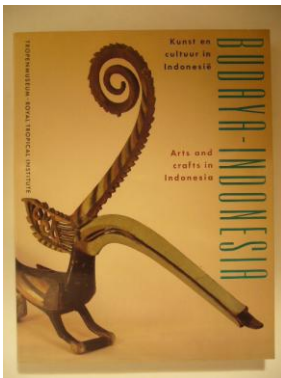

In its final stage of preparation, the supervision was with Dr. A.J. Pannekoek' (*Koeman VI, p.189*).

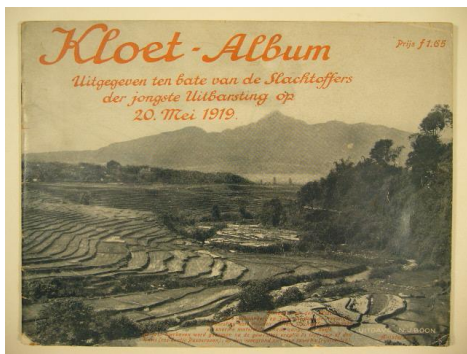

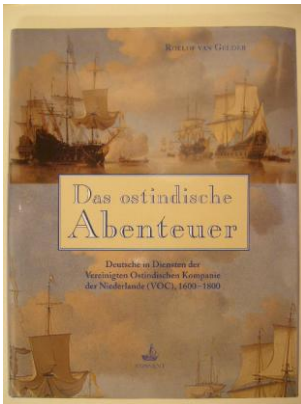

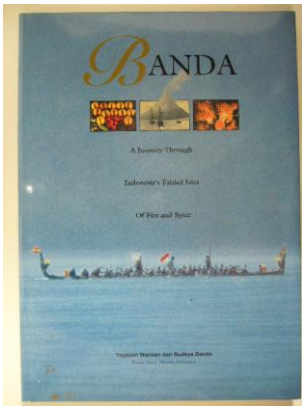

First edition. - Van Hoëvell asked for a voluntary discharge because he had been branded as 'suspect' in the Dutch East Indies. He wrote a pamphlet dealing with these events, but also based one of his novellas on them. It is called 'The Suspects', written

in 1858, and was included in his volume *About life in the Indies (Uit het Indische leven, 1860)*. It is one of his best works, and has remained relevant to this day. At once recognizable is the pattern it describes of an authoritarian society (*Nieuwenhuys, Mirror of the Indies, p.62*). The fine plates represents Indonesian figures, European characters, and a tiger seizing a buffalo at a water-hole. They are made by Pieter Marinus Trap, one of the best known of nineteenth century Dutch lithographic printers.
