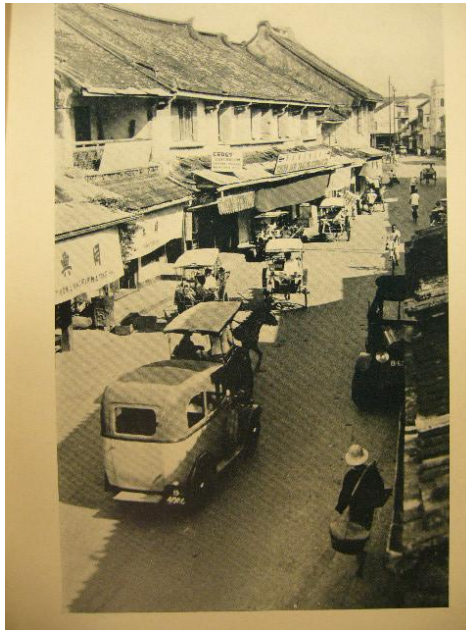
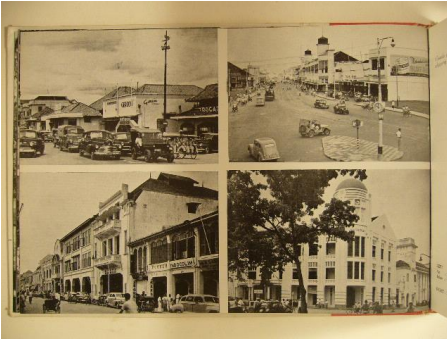


Illustration: item 75 **Hub. LEUFKENS**. Impressions of Batavia. 1939.

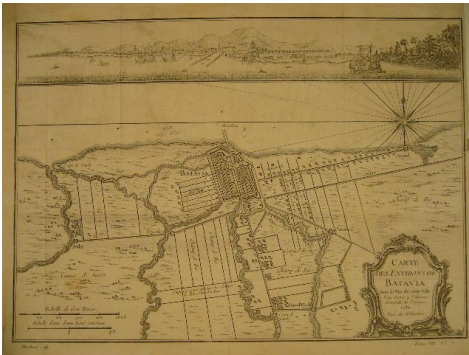

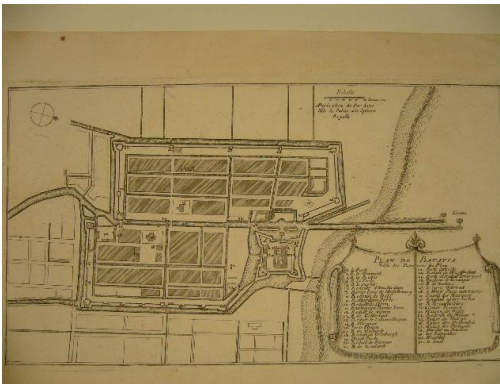

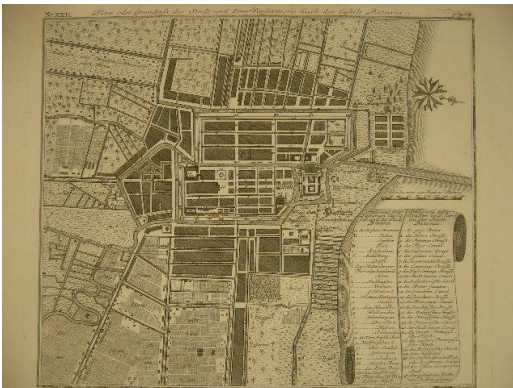
