IMAGES OF A VOYAGE TO ASIA AND BRAZIL



Johan Nieuhof (1618-1672) lived 9 years (1640-1649) in Brazil in the service of the Dutch West India Company (WIC). After the loss of Brazil he entered the service of the East India Company (VOC). Nieuhof provides firsthand information about his experiences, he was a keen observer of his surroundings, a skilful writer, and a fairly good descriptive artist (Lach, Asia in the making III, p.500).

His prints were presented 'from life' to a European audience for the first time, with a

multitude and variety of images that were unprecedented until then.

The fine plates we offer in this catalogue were inserted in his iconic books:

'Undoubtedly the finest 17th century plates of Indonesia are contained in Johan Nieuhof's Zee en lantreize '(*Bastin-Brommer p.1*). The many plates are exceedingly good' (*Lach, Asia in the making of Europe, III, p.501*).

Third edition, first published in 1665. - First embassy of the Dutch East India Company of Pieter de Goyer and Jakob de Keyser to the court of China in the years 1655-57, with fine engravings illustrating in detail Chinese life in the 17th century. Nieuhof's book is lavishly illustrated (providing) European readers with more realistic visual images of China's landscape and

people than ever before (*Lach*, *Asia in the making*, *III*, *p.484*. The illustrations by Nieuhof's book were one inspiration for *chinoiserie* which became especially popular in the 18th century. Many artists and architects based their designs on his pictures.






















