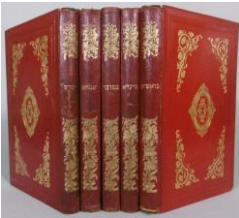

Robertus Junius (1606–1655) was the second VOC missionary sent to Dutch Formosa. He served two terms on the island for a total of fourteen years. From 1633 to 1639, he served in the same area as Georgius Candidius, the first missionary on Formosa. The mission on Formosa is unique in the history of the VOC, as it was the only area of the Company's possessions where a church emerged among non-Christians. This was largely due to Junius's efforts. Considered in Dutch church history as the reformer of Formosa, he baptized about 5,500 adults and educated 50 primary school teachers. He proposed to send pupils to the Netherlands for theological training; he translated sermons and the Heidelberg Catechism, and emphasized the importance of teaching in the vernacular.

*First German edition; original edition, Peregrinacão, published in Lisbon in 1614.* - Pinto (1509-1583), a Portuguese adventurer, merchant and traveller, embarked on his first voyage from Lisbon with the fleet of the son of Vasco da Gama for India in 1537 desiring to try his fortunes in the East. In about 1539 he was travelling independently. He was shipwrecked on the island of Tanixumaa (Japan) in 1542 and thus was the first European to enter Japan. After years as trader and adventurer in South-east Asia, China, Indonesia and India, Pinto returned to Portugal. After arriving in 1558 he wrote his famous '*Peregrinations*', published 30 years after his death in 1614. Pinto made four visits to Japan, he also gives first hand accounts of India, Abyssinia, Malacca, Sumatra, Java, Chine, Tartary etc. 'It is, moreover, a classic record of the experiences and observations of one of the earliest Europeans to penetrate into the interior of oriental countries, which, in that era, were practically unknown.' (Cox). Although many of his described adventures were too fantastic to be believed and earned him the sobriquet 'Prince of Lies', he was indeed the first known European to enter Japan. Petrus Plancius (born Pieter Platevoet) (1552 - 1622) was a Dutch-Flemish astronomer, cartographer and clergyman. Caspar Schwenckfeld von Ossig (1490 - 1561) was a German theologian, writer, and preacher who became a Protestant Reformer and spiritualist. He was one of the earliest promoters of the Protestant Reformation in Silesia.

He developed his own principles and had his own views on the sacraments. His followers became a new sect, which was outlawed in Germany, but his ideas influenced Anabaptism, Pietism on mainland Europe, and Puritanism in England. Many of his followers were persecuted in Europe and thus forced to either convert or flee. Schwenckfeld did not organize a separate church during his lifetime, but followers seemed to gather around his writings and sermons. One group arrived in the new colony of Pennsylvania in 1731, followed by five more migrations up to 1737. They became part of the larger Pennsylvania German or Pennsylvania Dutch culture of the region. In 1782, the Society of Schwenckfelders was formed, and in 1909 the Schwenckfelder Church was organized. By the early 1800s there were no more Schwenckfelders living in Europe. Today, four Schwenckfelder churches are in Montgomery or Philadelphia Counties, but nowhere else.

After the death of William III, who remained childless, in 1702, not only the succession as stadtholder was discredited, but the succession of the Marquisate of Veere was also disputed. It was not

until 1732 that the division of William III's inheritance took place. It was decided by the States that the feudal status of Veere and Vlissingen were lifted and promoted to free count cities, and were thus placed directly under the States themselves.

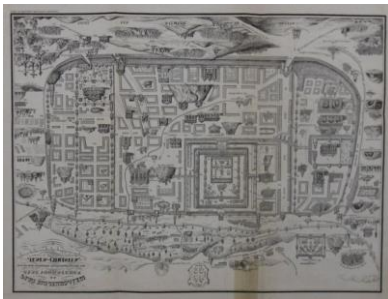

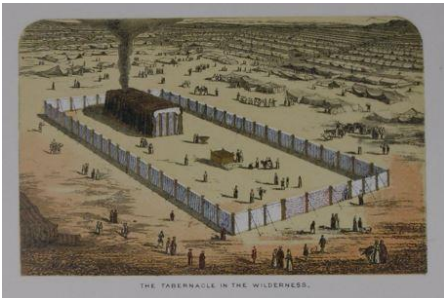

*First edition.* - The anonymous author of this extensive description of Batavia, the Queen of the East, claims to have received most of his information directly from the high officials of the Dutch East India Company (VOC) residing in Batavia. 'Batavia, capital city of the Netherlands Indies, site of a VOC post from 1610, and founded in 1619 by J.P. Coen, as regional headquarters for the Dutch East Indies Company, on the site of the Banten port of Jayakarta. It was first constructed as a Dutch city, complete with canals and walls to resist attack from Mataram, and much of the surrounding countryside was cleared of its inhabitants to create a kind of cordon sanitaire around the city. Batavia became a major center of settlement by Chinese, who lived within the city under their own laws. Tension between the Dutch and the Chinese led to a massacre of Chinese in 1740. The social composition of the city was also influenced by a large slave community, much of it Balinese in origin, who formed the basis for a constantly evolving mestizo culture in the city (*Cribb, Historical dictionary of Indonesia*, p.49-50). The first part gives a geographical and historical description of the island of Java and the city of Batavia. The second part describes the historical development and present state of government by the VOC. The third part presents a complete survey of the VOC trade. The fourth part describes the flora and fauna. In fact five of the fine plates are made after drawings by Johannes Rach (Het gouvernement te Batavia, de Markt te Batavia, De Diestpoort te Batavia, 't Kasteel te Batavia and a view depicting the harbour of Batavia).
